On December 23, 2008, the National Transmission Corporation (TRANSCO) filed an application for the approval of its connection charges and residual subtransmission charges for calendar year 2008 on the excluded services covering its existing subtransmission assets and any future concessionaire thereof, with prayer for provisional authority.

Relative thereto, on January 19, 2009, the Commission issued an Order provisionally authorizing TRANSCO to collect from its consumers the approved connection charges and residual subtransmission charges for calendar year


2007 until such time that the connection charges and residual subtransmission charges for calendar year 2008 shall have been determined.
