Power interruption in Eastern Samar

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) restored power transmission services in Eastern Samar on January 30, 2012 after re-energizing the Wright-Taft-Borongon 69kV Transmission Line.

Customers of Eastern Samar Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ESAMELCO) experienced the unplanned power interruption on January 30, 2012 which lasted from 8:02am to 5:03pm.

Reports indicate that an unidentified person intentionally cut the guy wires that support one of the transmission structures in Brgy. Polangi, Taft, Eastern Samar. The said structure collapsed, and caused the tripping of Wright-Taft-Borongon 69kV Transmission Line.
