NGCP donates relief goods to flood victims in Cotabato City

Power transmission provider and system operator National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) is donating P100,000 worth of relief goods to Cotabato City residents affected by the recent floods in the area.

It can be recalled that heavy rains in Cotabato City and surrounding areas in the last two weeks of June have caused these floods.

As part of its social responsibility initiatives in communities hosting its transmission facilities, NGCP representatives handed over the donation of canned goods and other food items to Cotabato City Mayor Japal Guiani on July 5 at the Cotabato City Hall.

NGCP operates and maintains high-voltage electrical facilities throughout the country including 19,575 circuit-kilometers of transmission lines and 25,842 megavolt amperes (MVA) of substation capacity.

Thirteen (13) barangays that host NGCP's Tacurong-Sultan Kudarat 69-kiloVolt Transmission Line have been affected by the floods. These are Tamontaka 2,3,4 5; Poblacion 3,4,7,8,9; and Rosary Heights 3,6,7,8.

NGCP assures its host communities that it will continue to work hand in hand with local government units and industry players like the distribution utilities to ensure continuous power service in the affected areas. ###
