NGCP energizes Gamu-Tuguegarao line, restores power in Cagayan, Kalinga, and Isabela

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) restored power transmission services to its customers in the provinces of Cagayan, Kalinga and parts of Isabela last night after energizing its Gamu-Tuguegarao line at 10:25 PM.

A power interruption to make way for the stringing, tapping and clipping of conductors and overhead ground wires on the newly erected towers along the said 230-kiloVolt was originally scheduled from 6:00 AM to 4:00 PM on July 3. Unforeseen problems, however, were encountered by the contractor working on the line and caused delays in the energization of the facility.

Affected customers CAGELCO I, CAGELCO II, KAELCO, ISELCO II, and NIA were duly informed of the scheduled shutdown prior to its implementation. NGCP appeals for the understanding of its customers for the unexpected delay in energization time. ###
