Scheduled power interruption in Parts of Iloilo and Capiz

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas:

Date: 04 February 2012

Time: 8:00AM-5:00PM

Affected Distribution Utility: * Capiz Electric Cooperative, Inc. (CAPELCO)

Reason: Replacement of poles along the Panit-an – Roxas 69kV transmission line

Date: 05 February 2012

Time: 8:00AM-5:00PM

Affected Distribution Utility: * Iloilo III Electric Cooperative, Inc. (ILECO III)

Reason: Maintenance activities at Panit-an-Sara 69kV transmission line

Normal operations will immediately resume after work completion. NGCP's customers and the general public are advised to take the necessary preparations and precautions for this scheduled interruption.

**Specific cities and municipalities to be affected by the power interruption are determined by the abovementioned Distribution Utility (DU), unless the activity affects the entire franchise area. The DU allots the available power within its franchise area and implements the power interruption schedule among the end-users.*
