Power interruption in parts of Maguindanao, Sultan Kudarat, and South Cotabato on September 11, 2011

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) restored power transmission services in parts of Maguindanao, Sultan Kudarat, and South Cotabato on Sunday, September 11, 2011 after re-energizing the Tacurong-Kabacan-Kibawe 138kV Transmission Line.

Maguindanao Electric Cooperative, Inc. (MAGELCO), Sultan Kudarat Electric Cooperative, Inc. (SUKELCO), and South Cotabato I Electric Cooperative, Inc. (SOCOTECO I) experienced a power interruption on September 11, 2011 which lasted from 2:43 PM–3:06PM.

NGCP line personnel patrolled the area immediately, but the cause of the said interruption is still undetermined as of press time.

Among the areas affected by the power interruption were Tacurong City and the Municipalities of Sultan Kudarat, Datu Odin Sinsuat, South Upi in Maguindanao and parts of South Cotabato.
