Rescheduling of Planned power interruption in parts of Negros Oriental

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas:

REASON OF RESCHEDULING: To synchronize the shutdown of 30MVA transformer by MTD on 24 July 2011 and at the same time divert resources to Amlan-Siaton line on 26 June 2011 due to critical level on the inventory of our steel poles.

Normal operations will immediately resume after completion of the works. NGCP's customers and the general public are advised to take the necessary preparations and precautions in anticipation of this scheduled interruption.
