### **Scheduled power interruption in parts of Compostela Valley, Davao del Norte and Davao Oriental Provinces**

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas:

Generosa and Mati City	Transfer of load from 100 MVA Alstom Power Transformer to 100MVA Iljin Power Transformer, in order to correct the hotspot on compressed connector, Phase A of drop conductor 69kV side of said Alstom transformer.

Normal operations will immediately resume after completion of the works. NGCP's customers and the general public are advised to take the necessary preparations and precautions in anticipation of this scheduled interruption.
