Scheduled power interruption in parts of Compostela Valley and Davao Oriental Provinces

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas:

26 June 2011	05:00AM – 06:00PM	Lupon S/S San Isidro S/S Mati S/S Davao Oriental		To implement the scheduled repair and maintenance of 35 structures along Maco-Mati and Manikling San Isidro 69kV Transmission Lines.
