Scheduled power interruption in parts of General Santos City and Sarangani Province

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas to facilitate the Annual Preventive Maintenance Schedule of the 50 MVA Power Transformer Unit No. 2 and its Associated HV Equipment in Gen. Santos Substation on **September 22, 2011** from **08:00 AM – 05:00 PM**.

A one-at-a-time testing of breaker feeders shall be implemented; hence, affected metering points are advised of the following power interruptions during operation:
