Scheduled power interruption in parts of Zamboanga Del Norte Province

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas:

	07:00AM and 05:00PM	ZAMSURECO II	To experience only brief interruptions around 07:00AM and 05:00PM Areas served by ZAMSURECO II's Magsaysay Substation (R.T. Lim and Tungawan, Zamboanga Sibugay and Vitali, Zamboanga City) and Dona Cecilia Substation (Sirawai, Siocon and Baliguian, Zamboanga del Norte)	Due to switching procedures to isolate the Ipil-Salug Line.
