### **Scheduled power interruption of Maramag-Malaybalay 69 kV Line**

The National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) serves notice of the scheduled shutdown of some of its transmission facilities in these areas:

This said power interruption will give way for the transfer of load back from our Kibawe Substation to Maramag Substation. The Maramag-Malaybalay 69kV section which was temporarily transferred due to the retrofitting works at Maramag Substation by the Maramag-Bunawan 230kV Project contractor.

Normal operations will immediately resume after completion of the works. NGCP's customers and the general public are advised to take the necessary preparations and precautions in anticipation of this scheduled interruption.
